Course Description: This workshop provides an introduction to the concept of Universal Design for Learning (UDL), and strategies for implementing UDL in the classroom. UDL is an approach to teaching and learning and the development of curriculum that draws on current brain research and new technologies to respond with flexibility to individual students' learning styles.

The workshop is designed to acquaint participants with UDL principles and provide practical, hands-on experience using a variety of free and low-cost examples of 21st century technology. Participants will explore how these tools can be incorporated into their classroom practice and plan a lesson that uses these tools.

About the Instructor: Adam Steiner has been a classroom teacher and technology integration specialist at the middle and high school level for over 15 years. He is currently an elementary and middle technology integration specialist for the Holliston Public Schools and is also a doctoral researcher at Boston College with a focus on assistive technology and technology/education leadership.
